The question is often asked — "How can I distinguish a model when the customer needs a part, and, for example, gives Maytag Serial No. 706802-A?". This particular number is a Model 32. The accompanying list will give you the answer for other models, and also indicate the duration of their manufacture.

IDENTIFICATION BY SERIAL NUMBER

The serial number on aluminum tub models is stamped on the side of the polished crown of the tub. On porcelain tub models, prior to December, 1949, the serial number was on a plate attached on the leg under the power unit, or a plate attached to the lower edge of the skirt. Since December, 1949, the serial number on Model J & N washers is stamped in the skirt directly below the rubber tub band, and centered with the patent transfer.
